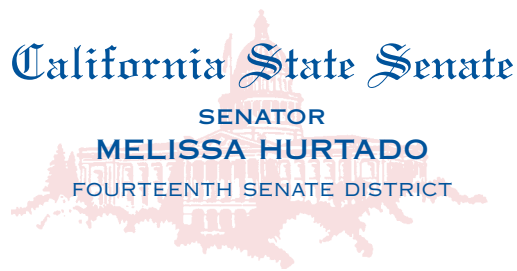

The Federal Communications Commission authorized the use of 211 – a special 3-digit dialing code – for information and referral services nationwide, with each state implementing its own program. California’s 211 program is overseen by the California Public Utilities Commission.

Call 211 for information on the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Pandemic. The COVID-19 situation in the U.S. is evolving rapidly as more becomes known about the virus, how it is spread, and how it affects people. 211 answers frequently asked questions and provides links to important resources. In addition, use 211 for assistance with finding food, paying household bills, and accessing free childcare or other essential services. All providers are operational and many are working closely with state and local health officials to provide up-to-date information.

Call 211 to find health and human service programs in your community. Professionally-trained information and referral providers can direct you to child care programs, mortgage assistance, job training, food and shelter, mental health services, drug and alcohol treatment, disaster response services and much more.

211 is free and confidential, available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and is available in more than 150 languages. Remember 211 the next time you need help. Don’t waste time searching the internet or being placed on hold; let 211 do the work for you. Just one call will connect you to the help you need.
